After his brother Tommy's death in November, 1956, an ailing Jimmy Dorsey led their band himself, struggling his way through a final tour of one-nighters and scoring the biggest hit of his career with "So Rare," before succumbing to cancer in June, 1957. Library of Congress Curator of Recorded Sound Matthew Barton will reconstruct Dorsey last months with new research and rediscovered recordings, including Christmas and New Year's broadcasts from December, 1956 and January 1957
